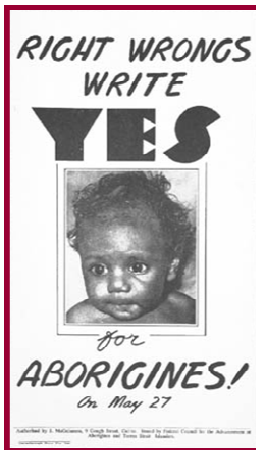




1967 REFERENDUM FORUM

Prior to 1967 Aboriginal people were not counted in the census, and a Referendum was held to consider a change to this policy. Many Aboriginal people, including Aboriginal women, worked passionately alongside non-Aboriginal people for the Yes Campaign. The result was a resounding victory to right this wrong.
